HOOK ##: Umpqua U608BL-BN or UC608BL-BN Competition Dry/Emerger or other

1XH, 2XL Curved, Ring Eye Hook, #8 - #16

THREAD: UTC or similar, 70 Denier, Brown

TAIL ##: Turkey Tail Tips, Brown

RIB ##: XSM Gold Tinsel or XSM Gold Wire

ABDOMEN ##: Pheasant Tail Fibers

WING (POST): Pheasant Tail Fibers ~ Using the same fibers that you used for the

abdomen; one bundle for the entire fly. If you're unable to make the wing post using the P.T. fibers, use any wing material that you have.

THORAX##: Fox Fur or Beaver Dubbing, Brown or Olive/Brown

HACKLE ##: Cock neck or saddle feather, Brown
