### **MATERIAL LIST**

**HOOK ##:** Umpqua U608BL-BN or UC608BL-BN Competition Dry/Emerger or other 1XH, 2XL Curved, Ring Eye Hook, #8 - #16

**THREAD:** UTC or similar, 70 Denier, Brown

**TAIL ##:** Turkey Tail Tips, Brown

**RIB ##:** XSM Gold Tinsel or XSM Gold Wire

**ABDOMEN ##:** Pheasant Tail Fibers

**WING (POST):** Pheasant Tail Fibers ~ Using the same fibers that you used for the abdomen; one bundle for the entire fly. If you're unable to make the wing post using the P.T. fibers, use any wing material that you have.

**THORAX##:** Fox Fur or Beaver Dubbing, Brown or Olive/Brown

**HACKLE ##:** Cock neck or saddle feather, Brown
