Created in the 1930s by Cliff Zug of Pennsylvania, the Zug Bug has been an effective cased caddis, pupa, emerger, and general attractor nymph for decades.

### **MATERIAL LIST**

**HOOK:** TMC 5262 or equiv. #8-16

**THREAD:** Black 8/0 or 70 Denier

**TAIL:** **##** Peacock Sword

**RIB:** **##** Fine Silver Tinsel or Silver Ultra Wire BR

**BODY:** **##** Peacock Herl

**LEGS:** **##** Brown Hen or Partridge

**WING CASE:** **##** Mallard flank

**HEAD:** Tying Thread
