HOOK: ## #6-#8 TMC 5212, Daiichi 1280, or similar 2XL or 3XL dry fly hook

THREAD: Orange UTC 140 Denier

BODY: ## Orange Polypropylene Yarn

WINGS: Light Elk Hair

HACKLE: 2–4 Brown Rooster Hackles (1½ – 2 times the hook gap)

ANTENNAE: Stripped Brown Hackle Stems
