A large Stonefly pattern imitating salmon flies or golden stones, fished dead drift or skittered on the hackle tips.

### **MATERIAL LIST**

**HOOK:** **##** #6-#8 TMC 5212, Daiichi 1280, or similar 2XL or 3XL dry fly hook

**THREAD:** Orange UTC 140 Denier

**BODY:** **##** Orange Polypropylene Yarn

**WINGS:** Light Elk Hair

**HACKLE:** 2-4 Brown Rooster Hackles (1½ – 2 times the hook gap)

**ANTENNAE:** Stripped Brown Hackle Stems
