**HOOK:** TMC 5212, 5262, 5263, 2302, 2312, or similar 2XL or 3XL, #6-#12

**THREAD:** UTC 140, 210 Denier, UNI 6/0, 3/0, Yellow, Purple, Fl. Orange, or other color of your choice.

**UNDERBODY:** Deer or Elk Hair

**TAIL:** Deer or Elk Hair (Tips of underbody hair)

**BODY:** Tying thread

**HEAD:** Deer or Elk Hair, bullet style

**WING:** Deer or Elk Hair (Tips of head Hair)

**LEGS:** **##** White Rubber Legs, size Medium
