HOOK: Standard dry-fly hook (TMC 100 or similar), size 14

THREAD: UTC 70 Denier, Rusty brown

BODY: Deer hair, flared, spun and trimmed

ANTENNA: Hackle quill, brown **HACKLE**: Dry-fly hackle, Brown

OPTIONAL MATERIAL: Zap-A-Gap or Super Glue

You'll need a double edged razor blade for trimming the deer hair.
