

MATERIAL LIST

HOOK: **##** Montana Fly Co. 7204, Firehole 551 or similar 60 degree wide gape jig hook, #14-18 (Terry will tie on a #14 hook)

BEAD: **##** 5/32" (3.8mm) slotted tungsten bead, color: copper

THREAD: Veevus Body Quill BQ8, color: Brown (substitute: Brown UTC 70 thread)

TAIL: Coq de Leon fibers

BODY: Veevus Body Quill BQ8, color: Brown (substitute: Brown UTC 70 thread)

RIB: Small silver wire

BODY SEALER: Solarez Bone Dry (substitute: other thin clear UV resin or 5 minute epoxy)

WING CASE: Gulff Black Magic (substitute: other black UV resin or black nail polish or black sharpie)

HOT SPOT: Veevus Body Quill BQ14, color: Fluorescent Orange (substitute: Fl. Orange UTC 70 thread or orange floss)
