MATERIAL LIST

HOOK: TMC5263 or other nymph hook of your choosing, #12,14,16. (I'll tie on #14)

BEAD: Gold tungsten bead, 7/64"

THREAD: 8/0 or 70 denier, grey or tan

TAIL: **##** Mallard Flank Barbs, natural or dyed wood duck

RIB: Fine gold or copper wire

BODY: Hare's Ear Dubbing

WING CASE: **##** Large Flat Pearl Tinsel

THORAX: Hare's Ear Dubbing

HACKLE: **##** Partridge (Collar on version 1, Legs on version 2)

NOTE: *Fish under an indicator along weed lines or slowly stripped. Using these patterns at Utah lakes Chris has landed 19"+ Rainbows and Tigers.*
