### **MATERIAL LIST**

**HOOK: ##** TMC 200R #16–10 (I'll tie on a #14)

**THREAD:** UTC 70 denier, White or Tan or Gray Brown

**TAIL: ##** Coq de Leon fibers

**BODY: ##** CDC Feathers, Beige & Cream

**WING CASE: ##** CDC Feathers, Beige

**WINGS: ##** CDC Feathers, 1 White, 1 Cream & 1 Blue Dun, or 3 of the same color

***## - If needed these items will be available for in-person tiers.***

***A Petitjean Magic Tool or something similar will be used for tying this fly.***
