BEAD: Black 3/32 (optional)

THREAD: Dark, fine

RIB:## Fine gold wire

BODY:## Flash: Medium holographic green or pearl mylar

BODY:## Small caddis green or tan vernille or ultra chenille

ANTENNAE:## Barred mayfly tail or teal flank, mallard flank

LEGS:## (optional) partridge or other feathers

THORAX:## Ostrich Herl, Black or dark gray

NOTE: Bring a BIC or similar lighter
