

HOOK: TMC100 or 101, #16 - 18

THREAD: UTC 70, color of your choice

BODY/ANTENNA: ## A two bump piece shelf liner, color of your choice (see the

important note below)

WING: Antron yarn, Zelon, McFlylon, etc. ~ white or any color that's most visible to

you.

LEGS: Grizzly dry fly hackle, sized to the hook

Other items needed: 1) Super Glue

2) Optional) Red, Black, Brown and Yellow Sharpies

It's available at Walmart, Amazon, Lowes, Office Depot, Sam's Club and probably more places in a variety of colors ~ white is good if you want to color your ant. Use the rest to line your kitchen drawers!
