MATERIAL LIST

HOOK: ## #12-20 Fulling Mill 5045 Jig Hook (or any similar jig nymph hook)

BEAD: ## Silver or Nickel slotted sized to hook

THREAD: Olive UTC 70 or similar thread that can be split (not UNI)

TAIL: Coq de Leon Rooster Hackle Fibers

BODY: ## Stripped & Dyed Peacock Quill

THORAX: ## Fox Squirrel Dubbing

HOT SPOT: ## Fluorescent Fire Orange Antron Yarn (or Glo-Brite Floss or UNI Floss)

LEGS: ## Natural Dun CDC Fibers

Other items needed: super glue, dubbing tool, sharp bodkin

- These items will be available for in-person tiers if needed. If you know you're going to need material please arrive early enough to get everything before our scheduled start time.
