- Presenting the backcast

General Information

These rules apply to both the silent and live auctions. Pick up your auction bidder number when you checkin, you will need it for both auctions. Telephone bids may be made with Steve Esgate at (818) 723–5122.

Terms of Sale

General auction rules will prevail. ~ All items are sold "as is". ~ All sales are final. ~ Many prices or values are rounded to the nearest dollar, and include sales tax when applicable.

Lodges, B&B's, Outfitters & Guides

Unless otherwise specified in the items description, trips to lodges or bed & breakfast inns, or with outfitters or guides are on a "2 for 1" basis. One guest is free when you pay the published price to the lodge, B&B, outfitter or guide. This means that either (a) two anglers go for the price of one, or (b) you pay for one day and get a second day free. The description of each item specifies which way it works and for that item, and the current published price. Your total cost will be that price, plus the amount of your bid. The successful bidder will receive a certificate, which generally must be used within one year. Unless otherwise noted, out-of-state fishing licenses, gratuities, and transportation to and from the destination are not included.

Payment Procedure

- All Silent Auction and Live Auction bids must be paid the evening of the event, or that bid is void and the next lower bidder will be the winner. Auction items that are "Special Order" will include instructions for payment.
- Payment maybe paid by cash, check payable to SPFF FOUNDATION, or Credit/Debit Card.

Silent Auction

- The silent auction will begin at 5:30 PM.
- Most silent auction items are listed in this catalog. There may be some last minute items that are not listed so look carefully!
- Each item has a minimum price and a minimum bid increase. Bids for less than the minimum price, or increases for less than minimum increase, are void.
- Please clearly print your Bidder Number on the bid sheets. Illegibly written bids (Bidder Number and/or Bid Amount) will be disregarded.
- After the auctioneer announces a section is closed, any bid entered in that section is void.
- Please do NOT block others from access to bid card(s) you're interested in. If a complaint of blocking is
 made to the Auctioneer, he or she may extend the closing for such item(s) until all interested bidders are
 finished, or moves such item(s) to the live auction, with the amount of the last legal silent auction bid on
 behalf of that bldder.
