

#### **DECEMBER MESSAGE**

### **SWCFFI ELECTIONS**

During the month of December, members of the Southwest Council who are also members of Fly Fishers

International will receive an electronic ballot via Survey Monkey from FFI. Members who do not have email, will receive ballots via the USPS. The ballot will contain the Southwest Council slate for the 2021 Board of Directors. Due to Board members resigning before their two year term had ended, we are using this election to get everyone back on track so that all terms will begin at the same time. All members of the Board of Directors will serve a term of two years from January 2021-2023.

The ballot will contain pictures of those nominated. A short bio of each candidate will be placed on the Southwest Council's website at: <a href="https://www.swcffi.org">https://www.swcffi.org</a> Rather than approve each candidate individually, you will provide a, "Yes" or "No" vote for the entire slate.

The current Board of Directors decided to have the General Membership Meeting at our Winter Quarterly Meeting in which elections can take place with an "In person vote". However due to the use of Zoom meeting format, we have asked Fly Fishers International for assistance in the voting process. As such, our 2021 Board of Directors will be introduced at our Winter Quarterly Meeting on Saturday, January 16th, 2021.

#### **A FEW MENTIONS**

As President for the past two years, I have had the opportunity to work with FFI on the national level. Our Southwest Council is highly respected and is involved in many of the FFI programs on a national level. **Leigh Ann Swanson**, our VP/Education, has been working with Dutch Baughman on developing the FFI Learning Center. One of their projects is putting together a leadership workshop that is presented at the Expo and Regional Expos. This year, Dutch has asked the Southwest Council to present our Club Management Day within the workshop.

Club Management Day, which we have in January, was a suggestion from **Carol Katz (Healing Waters)** made to **Michael Schweit (President Emeritus)** and we have been incorporating this into our Winter Quarterly meeting for the last ten years.

**Karen Hall** has been a force for us with the Women's Program and she has also been recognized on a national level to help other councils in developing a similar women's program. She will be speaking to the President's Council Meeting in December.

**Debbie Sharpton** is our Conservation Director and has been involved in contacts with National as well as Northern California Council. A monumental agreement to remove four of the Klamath River dams was signed last week by both Governor Newsom of California, Governor Kate Brown of Oregon, Tribal leaders of the Kurok and Yurok nations, and owner of the dams PacifiCorp and Berkshire Hathaway. This will go a long way to restore Steelhead and Salmon to this important fishery as well as develop a suitable habitat for trout.

#### THE BUILDING BLOCKS OF THE FFI

The strength of FFI comes from the base of our clubs, both affiliate and charter. FFI started out as a federation of clubs, those being affiliate clubs. Affiliate clubs usually only have a small portion of their members subscribed as FFI members.

Within the Southwest Council, most clubs have only 20% of their members belonging to FFI, and over 80% of the clubs within Southwest Council are affiliate clubs. The same is true across the country.

The low FFI membership rate within affiliate clubs brings a sense of disconnect unless the Council shows why being affiliated with FFI is a positive thing. It's a constant effort. I believe that the Southwest Council has been doing a good job of promoting our clubs throughout the region.

We get involved on a national level, a regional level, and a local level. We are the only international organization devoted to fly fishing.

We bring many clubs together to share events, workshops, and learning opportunities. There is a synergy when clubs work together and share experiences, it enhances the positive aspects of fly fishing that all members get to relish and enjoy. And, that group involvement is what SWC FFI brings to the table. All the other stuff, insurance, learning center, expos, is the side dishes. It's what we do together that is the main Turkey.

#### LAS VIRGENES CREEK PROJECT

Over the last 10 years SWCFFI Conservation efforts included restoration work on Malibu Creek, a local historic southern steelhead trout water ranging from Rindge Dam public awareness, steelhead monitoring, and non-native invasive species removal.

Malibu Creek is a Core 1 stream system for the federally endangered Southern California steelhead trout.

Recently, SWCFFI received a grant from Los Angeles County Third District Supervisor Kuehl to continue public education and physical removal of nonnative aquatic species in Las Virgenes Creek, a tributary of Malibu Creek.

Las Virgenes Creek contains suitable steelhead spawning habitat and also supports another threatened species, the California Red-Legged Frog.

Parties to announce key development in ambitious salmon restoration project

SACRAMENTO – Governor Gavin Newsom, Oregon Governor Kate Brown, leaders of the Karuk and Yurok Tribes, Berkshire Hathaway Energy and PacifiCorp today will discuss efforts to advance the removal of four hydroelectric dams on the Klamath River to address declines in fish populations, improve river health and renew Tribal communities and cultures.

#### LEGENDS OF FLY TYING

#### HAIRWING CONVERSION TECHNIQUES WITH JIM FERGUSON

The Dusty Miller is a classic Atlantic Salmon pattern that uses feathers for the wing of the fly. The Hairwing Conversion technique replaces the feathers used in the wings, sides, and cheeks with hair. Many of the classic Atlantic Salmon patterns can be converted to a hairwing style that fishes well for steelhead.

FFI Buz Buszek Award recipient, Jim Ferguson, teaches and demonstrates the Hairwing Conversion technique and how to select, prepare, and mount the hair used to replace feathers in these classic fly patterns. Jim has been tying flies for over 60 years. He lives in Oregon and is heavily involved in local fishing and conservation organizations, tying flies at fishing shows, and teaching fly tying.

TROUT UNLIMITED | On the Southern California Coast - restoring access to precious habitat for endangered southern steelhead—our most resilient native species—on the Santa Margarita River in Orange County. This project will realize one of the few opportunities to restore access to an entire watershed for Southern steelhead.

In the northern Central Valley - on the North Fork of Battle creek we are removing a major migration barrier for endangered Sacramento winter-run Chinook salmon. Battle Creek, with its cold spring waters flow from Lassen Peak, provide much-needed habitat for one our most at-risk salmon runs.

On the North Coast - in the backyard of the communities of McKinleyville and Arcata we are providing refuge and nursing habitat for native steelhead, coho and Chinook salmon through off-channel habitat recovery and public access improvements on the Mad River Estuary.


