HOOK: TMC101 #10-12 or TMC100 #8-12 or TMC2312 #8-12

THREAD: 8/0 or 70 denier, color to match the body

BODY: ## Natural or Synthetic Fur

WING: ## Deer Hair

HACKLE: Rooster, light dun or other color most visible to YOU.

Important Wing/Body color combinations

Brown wing/Yellow body,

Brown wing/Bright Green body,

Gray wing/Gray body,

Ginger wing/Cream body
