Steelhead flies have recently been requested so I'm going to do a couple of very easy ones: a **STEELIE OMELET & A RAG EGG FLY**



STEELIE OMELET MATERIAL LIST

HOOK: TMC 2457 or equiv., #10

THREAD: UTC 140 denier, Fl Orange

BODY: # Medium Estaz, (AKA Pearl Chenille, Cactus Chenille), Orange
(Chartreuse, Pink, Blue are optional colors)

BLOOD DOT: # Medium Estaz, Red

RAG EGG FLY MATERIAL LIST

HOOK: TMC 2457 or equiv., #10

THREAD: # UTC 130 G.S.P., White

EGG: # Glo Bug Yarn, in Orange, Pink, Chartreuse & Red. (All 4 colors; if you don't have 4 colors, use what you have, 1 color will be OK).

If you don't have G.S.P. thread, use 6/0, 140 or 210 denier in orange red, white or a color you have.
