MATERIAL LIST

Hook: Scud hook e.g. TMC 2457 or Jig Hook e.g. J Stockard 604. Sizes 6-14. (*Rick will first tie on a TMC 2457 #8, then on a J. Stockard 604 #12*)

Thread: Tan UTC 70 denier or other 6/0 or 8/0

Bead: Gold Tungsten, sized to your hook. (use slotted beads for jig hooks)

Added Weight: 0.020" Lead free wire

Legs and Tails: Goose biots in natural grey.

RIbbing: Red wire, size Brassie

Wing Cases: Mottled Turkey, pre-coated with Workable Fixatif or Flexament

Body & Thorax: Hare's Ear dubbing, natural

<u>REMEMBER</u> ~ it's perfectly OK to substitute materials for our classes. USE WHAT YOU HAVE & LEARN THE TYING TECHNIQUE.
