MATERIAL LIST

Hook: TMC 200 R size 8-18 ~ John will be tying a size 12

Thread: UTC 140 denier Fl Orange

Tail: Bleached elk or deer hair

Abdomen: Bright yellow dubbing (you can also use orange, olive or black.)

Thorax: Amber dubbing (bright orange is also used with the yellow body .

Rib: Fine gold wire

Hackle: I use brown palmered through the abdomen. But you can use blue dun ginger or furnace. It should be at least two sizes smaller that the hook would normally call for.
John will use grizzly for the thorax but again feel free to use almost any color you like.

Wing: same as the tail

REMEMBER ~ it's perfectly OK to substitute materials for our classes. USE WHAT YOU HAVE & LEARN THE TYING TECHNIQUE.
