He'll be tying one in Sculpin Olive and one in Black



MATERIAL LIST

Hook: #14-18 Tiemco 2488H or similar, I'll be using size16 ***

Thread: Olive or Black 70 Denier or smaller

Body: Peacock Krystal Flash for Olive Leech ***

Red Krystal Flash for Black Leech

Wing: Sculpin Olive Wapsi Micro Pine Squirrel for Olive Leech ***

Black Wapsi Micro Pine Squirrel for Black Leech

Thorax: Dark Green or Olive Ostrich Herl (large) for Olive Leech ***

Black Ostrich Herl (large) for Black Leech

Note: you can substitute hackle for ostrich herl, sized to gap of hook

Note: UV Resin, thin and clear, is suggested to coat body but not required

*** I will bring extra for in person tiers if needed

REMEMBER ~ it's perfectly OK to substitute materials for our classes. USE WHAT YOU HAVE & LEARN THE TYING TECHNIQUE.
