### **MATERIAL LIST**

**HOOK: ##** TMC 2457 #12-16

**BEAD: ##** 7/64" for #12-14 hook, 3/32" for #16 hook, Copper (or other color of your choice) Tungsten Bead

**THREAD: 6/0 or 140 Denier Rusty Brown** (or other color of your choice)

**FLASH: ##** Red Flashabou

**TAIL: ##** ♦ Rusty Brown Pine Squirrel Zonker Strip

**COLLAR: ##** ♦ Fur from Rusty Brown Pine Squirrel Zonker Strip

**## - If needed these items will be available for in-person tiers.**

- ♦ - You could use Black, Olive, Brown, Purple, Orange, Red Pine Squirrel for the tail and collar. Also, you might consider making the collar a different color than the tail.
