### **MATERIAL LIST**

**HOOK:** TMC 100 or 2587 size 16-18

**THREAD:** UTC 70D, Veevus 12/0, Uni 8/0 Tan or brown

**SHUCK ##:** Zelon (or Darlon) brown olive plus mallard flank in natural.

**ABDOMEN ##:** Turkey biot to match natural

**WING CASE ##:** Closed cell foam, 1 or 2 mm, black, , cut to 2 mm width for above sized hooks.

**THORAX:** PMD dry fly dubbing

**WINGS ##:** Natural or dun CDC x 2 feathers
